## NOTABLE CASES

HKSAR v Lew Mon Hung (2019) 22 HKCFAR 159

- Led by Mr. Joseph Tse S.C. for the Appellant who had been convicted of doing acts with intent to pervert the course of justice. Leave was granted to appeal to the Court of Final Appeal and the appeal hearing was heard in May 2019.

Secretary for Justice v Chan Chi Wan (2017) 20 HKCFAR 98

- Led by Mr. Joseph Tse S.C. for the 1st Appellant who had been convicted of conspiracy for an agent to accept an advantage. The appeal was allowed and the conviction was quashed.

HKSAR v Chen Keen and others, ESCC 1834/2012

- Led by the late Mr. Alexander King S.C. for the 1st Defendant in a preliminary inquiry.
